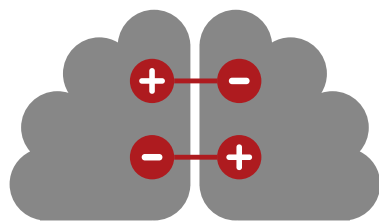
Dear Friends and Colleagues!

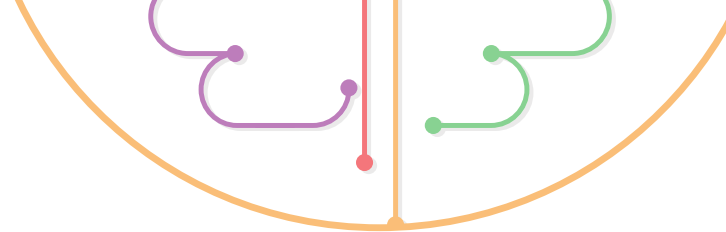
